DETAILED PROJECT PROPOSAL

BACKGROUND INFORMATION & NEED OF THE PROJECT

India is economically, socially and educationally backward one. Because we have many social problems, the peaceful life is disturbed. According to the latest statistics, the percentage of literates in Uttar Pradesh State is only 67.68% which is comparatively lower with other States in India. That too there are no more highly qualified people. It is identified where there is no more education the growth of economy is less.

Sambhal is one of the 3 districts in the newly formed on 28 September, 2011 state of Uttar Pradesh in India with a population around 2,200,000 as per the census of 2011. Majority of the population 65% families here live below the poverty line. More than 70 per cent of the populations do little bit of farming and they do not have even the minimum basic facilities like proper housing, drinking water, education, healthcare etc.

Most of the people of Sambhal district living in the village are landless, agricultural, laborers whose livelihood depends on daily wages.

Draught or excess rainfall and flood are frequent phenomena here and it adds to their extreme poverty. As their whole farming depends on the benevolence of nature and the scarcity of rain, when it is needed not getting it or untimely rain damages their crops. Modern techniques of farming are not much used in these areas. They still use bulls and buffaloes for farming. Besides, most of them take agriculture loans with high interests from the local landlords and often fail to return them due to poor crops and remain in debts. The people who seek work with others also do not have regular works. Only during certain seasons they get work. All these contribute to their poor and pathetic living conditions and keep them always under the threat of real poverty, starvation and sickness.

Clean drinking water is a basic necessity of life. Supply of clean drinking water in the rural areas has always been one of the highest priorities of people. The community at a large suffers a lot because of lack of clean water. The sanitation is poor because of lack of water. The inadequate availability of safe drinking water has been found as the principal reason for the socio-economic backwardness of minority population. It is found that as much as 23.22 per cent in the district as against the 87.90 per cent in the country has the inadequate supply of safe drinking water. Lack of water and unclean water leads to several diseases that affect children, women and aged specially.

The Socio-economic condition and due to crushing poverty, a lot of families of proposed area are unable to have their daughters and sisters get married. They could not arrange expenses amount to marry her daughter, so many girls are living with out marriage with her parents.

In these difficult situations HGVS provides support for marriage of young girls from impoverished families who cannot afford the marriage expenses. The support them with basic necessary items includes provision of furniture, jewelry, clothes, shoes, utensils, fan, sewing machine etc. along with some financial assistance to offset other marriage expenses. Priority is given to orphans and the very poor.

Government schemes reach them seldom. Really these people as they look the government and non-governmental organizations for some kind of support to enable their lives.

Horizon Gramudhyog Vikas Samiti (HGVS) is having rich experience of working with the poor communities in the rural areas of Sambhal district. HGVS is already working at the grass root level from last 8 years for the support of vulnerable groups through various welfare activities i.e. providing food ration, clothes, book, uniforms, stationeries, skills development, safe drinking water etc. on own efforts.

During the implementation, **HGVS** observed other immediate needs of the people in the areas and realized that many people were suffering due to damages to their houses, Safe drinking water, Poor Girls Marriage etc.

Now as per need of the area **HGVS** has decided to continue their support, for this purpose **HGVS** design a proposal for **conducting various “SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES” for the support of most Vulnerable Groups in Sambhal district of Uttar Pradesh State.**

PROJECT PROPOSED

Taking into consideration the urgency of the situation and need of the area **HGVS** propose for a project seeking **aid for the support of most Vulnerable Groups with various “SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES”**. The details of the proposed project and the other necessary documents are submitting for your kind perusal.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- ☞ To provide Shelter for affected and Homeless people to save the lives from winter, Rains and Hot Sun.
- ☞ To Installation of Tube Well (Hand pumps) and Provide clean potable water to most Vulnerable.
- ☞ To providing clean and safe drinking water to all villages
- ☞ To giving special attention for water supply to less privileged community especially people who live in remote villages.
- ☞ To provide financial support in Poor Girls Marriage
- ☞ To provide Winterization kits to most vulnerable
- ☞ To organize preventive health care seminars.
- ☞ To provide free basic health facilities and quality medicines to poor
- ☞ To provide Uniforms, Books and Stationeries to most vulnerable children.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT / METHODOLOGY

This project focuses on vulnerable families who not have even the minimum basic facilities like proper housing, drinking water, education, healthcare etc. There are many families in rural and urban areas of Sambhal district that have no proper houses to stay in. Most of them have only very old shelter which is at the brink of collapsing and in the rainy season they live a very miserable life. The summer temperature (the mercury goes up above 42 degree centigrade) is so horrible that they not are able to stay inside, that they go to road side to sleep in the night. A house of their own will surely boost the morale of the people here and will raise the prospects of them being socially accepted by other classes of people. The project will also help the families to settle in one place and thus plan for the future, especially with regard to the education of their children.

Before implementing the project, Organization will do a base line survey door to door in a prescribed format to identify the beneficiaries and also shall Consult Aaganwari, Gram Panchayat, Post office, Local banks & Local authorities for selection of beneficiaries.

Organization will conduct the effective training module and will provide the knowledge, tools and technique to volunteers about the Baseline Survey by master resource person.

After the selection of beneficiaries HGVS will provide following support through proposed project -

- Construct 100 house; each house is with in 300 s.q.ft., which includes latrine and bathroom. The cost of each house is **Rs. 220000** (Two Lakhs Twenty Thousand INR only).

- Installation of 20 Deep Tube wells and 20 hand pumps; The cost of each tube well is **Rs. 50000** and hand pump is **Rs. 10000** (Fifty and Ten Thousand INR Respectively).
- Support in 100 poor girls marriage; The cost of marriage of one young girl approximately **Rs. 230000** (Two Lakhs Thirty Thousand INR only).
- For the winter season 2019/2020, HGVS is targeting 1,000 families to provide **winterization kits/items** such as blankets, mats and mattresses to 800 families. One family set includes five blankets, two mattresses and two mats. The cost of a kit is **Rs. 6000** (Six Thousand INR only).
- Provide checkup and quality medicines facility to 1000 poor people; The cost of one person is **Rs. 1500** (One Thousand INR only).
- Provide Uniforms, Books and Stationeries to 800 vulnerable children. The cost of one child is **Rs. 2500** (Two Thousand Five Hundred INR only).

This project would be completed with in a period of two years from the date of sanction. **HGVS** will implement the plan with the civil engineering and social care team. Project implementation, accounts, monitoring and reporting will be done as per the guidelines of the granting agency.

THE TIME FRAME OF THE PROJECT

Initially, the project has been planned basing on a two (2) year period for purposes of systematic costing.

MONITORING REPORTING AND EVALUATION

Monitoring:

The entire project will be monitored by the monitoring team and timely documentation and evaluation will be made on it. The monitoring team can be appointed by the funding agency or by the organization. The team will be monitoring the financial as well as the physical matters. however; **HGVS** Civil Engineering team would monitor the quality, time, organizing manpower and progress. We like to make the monitoring team on the basis of community participation.

Reporting & Evaluation:

There will be a project manager to monitor the entire program and to document the activities. Progress report would be furnished on monthly basis and the same would be reported annually.

The project would be evaluated with the consultation and guidelines of the granting agency. Committee shall organize regular periodical review meeting to analyze whether the objectives of the project have been met and achieved it will be the self evaluation routine process of the institution.

THE PROFILE OF THE ORGANIZATION

Horizon Gramudhyog Vikas Samiti is a non-profitable and non-governmental voluntary organization registered under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 (**Regd. No.- 823/2009-2010, Dated on 28th July 2009**).

Horizon Gramudhyog Vikas Samiti (**HGVS**) is a overall integrated Development Organization which committed to work for the development and upliftment of the vulnerable groups to eradicate poverty and also dedicated to improve the environmental hazards. We as an NGO is working to promote and provide qualitative education to neglected children and down trodden communities which are socially and economically deprived. Further more we emphasize these children's latest talents and explore, so that they not only acquire academic learning, but also vocational proficiency, personal character and societal values. We work for their retention until they become self reliant and responsible citizens.

HGVS emphasis on the formal education for drop-out and non enroll children. As per statistical data there are large numbers of drop out and hardly 50% boys and 30% girls qualify 10+2 standard though the facilities are available in every village of India. We had surveyed in the several villages where we came to know the facts and factual reasons of drop outs and our study says the following drastic reasons.

HGVS leads the community towards good health through its health program. We organize health awareness camps in which Doctor diagnose the disease and refer the patients in Government Hospitals where confessional rates are charged. We also organize Eye screening camps in the villages where cataract patients are benefited by referring

the patients for IOL operation on very minimum charges. The patient who has weak eye sight is given spectacles on concessional rates.

KEY OBJECTIVES OF THE ORGANIZATION

Emphasis on literacy movement to make the entire female to literate as well as enroll the girl child in formal school. Provide better health care facilities by organizing regular camps, health education meetings, and door to door awareness campaign about RCH issues, better nutrition management program, Sanitary Hygienic practice etc. Providing livelihood and increasing opportunities for landless families is a major focus area of **HGVS**. Women & youth would be mobilized to form small groups which are based on the income generation and occupation. Women to be engaged in micro credit units to form a big cooperative for their economic enhancement. People to get their lawful rights & privilege of Government Schemes are another major goal of HGVS.

1. To create awareness in rural farmers and labourers. To create social, cultural and economic awareness in poor children with better planning.
1. To create awareness of democratic and basic rights in farmers and labourers.
2. To organize cooperative societies of farmers and labourers.
3. To promote handicraft by organizing camps and participating in exhibitions.
4. To make planning for rural development and find out the same organization for economic help.
5. To organize camps for awareness of the weaker sections such as widow, poor, SC & ST, handicapped and mentally retarded persons for their social upliftment.
6. To foster a spirit of mutual help and good will among the member of the society.

7. To accept donation, grants, presents, gifts and other offering (in the shape of movable or immovable properties) as well as sale and purchase for the promotion of aims and objects of the society.
8. To organize various charities services programmes for needy people on the basis of no profit no loss.
9. The property of the society shall be for the society development and no any part of property, bonus, and dividends will be paid to any members of the society.
10. To establish and organize the self help groups in the village for giving the training of handicrafts such as sewing and cutting, embroidery, mudha making, clay modelling, toy making, painting, wooden craft, pottery making, mat making etc.
11. To promote the plantation for environmental purposes.
12. To provide information and education about AIDS diseases through holding awareness camps as well as help in their treatment.
13. To encourage people for environmental awareness and program for consumer awareness.
14. To promote and help the people about the adoption of new technology such as biogas, solar energy, computer training, handicraft etc.

16. To take up research work program in the society at any subject and give information of results to the people and institution.

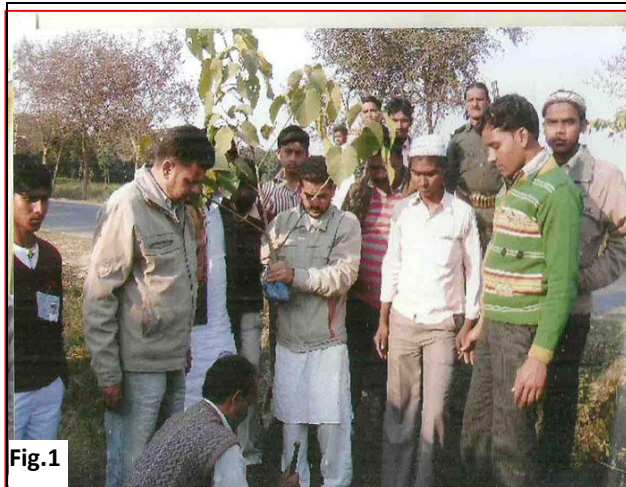

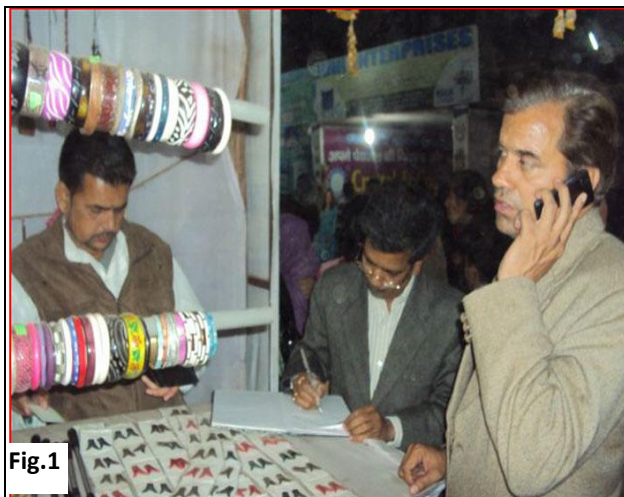

PROFILE OF PROJECT AREA – SAMBHAL DISTRICT, UTTAR PRADESH

Sambhal is a Muslim majority city in India with approximately 77.67% of city population following Islam as their religion. Hinduism is second most popular religion in city of Sambhal with approximately 22.00% following it. The total population of Sambhal over 21 lacs has become one of the most crowded cities in Uttar Pradesh.

Today, the city of Sambhal is famous for manufacturing of its unique kinds of horn and bone crafts items which are being exported. There is an exponential increase in environmental pollution and occupational health hazards due to rapid industrialization. The food stuffs are largely adulterated, drinking water supply becoming scare and unsafe for consumption and lastly industries and automobiles have increased the atmospheric air pollution to an alarmingly unsafe levels. This has led to a steep fall in health standards of the people.

1. Sambhal Population 2011

As per provisional reports of Census India, population of Sambhal in 2011 is 221,334; of which male and female are 116,008 and 105,326 respectively. Although Sambhal city has population of 221,334; its urban / metropolitan population is 0 of which 0 are males and 0 are females.

2. Sambhal Literacy Rate 2011

In education section, total literates in Sambhal city are 92,608 of which 51,382 are males while 41,226 are females. Average literacy rate of Sambhal city is 49.51 percent of which male and female literacy was 52.27 and 46.45 percent.
