DETAILED PROJECT PROPOSAL

BACKGROUND INFORMATION & NEED OF THE PROJECT

Madrasa literally means “a place where learning and studying are done”. In the Arabic language, the word Madrasa simply means the same as school does in the English language, whether that is private, public, or parochial school as well as for any primary or secondary school whether Muslim, non-Muslim, or secular.

The basic aim of the Madrasa is the protection and promotion of knowledge of the Deen (Islam). This Islamic educational set up wants to create a society based on justice, peace, tolerance, world brotherhood, equality, and egalitarianism. There would be no exaggeration in mentioning this truth that if Islam and Muslim civilization is alive across the globe, it's because of these Madrasa and its products. These Madrasa are the main tools which transmit and transfer the Prophets teaching to the present generations and posterity. These institutions are the main channels of Da'wah (preaching in Islam).

The number of Madrasa in India is estimated to be between thirty to forty thousands. According to the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, there are more than 15,000 Maktabas and over 10,000 Madrasa in Uttar Pradesh. Similar are the figures for the other States of India.

In addition, Madrasas and the product of these institutions are the real guardians, custodians, and real harbingers of our Muslim society. There is no doubt in saying that Madrasa students are getting a catena of information regarding the Islam, but it's also a reality that found themselves in quagmire and doldrums situations when they came out

from these institutions towards universities or colleges where they face numerous problems because of having very less insight about the modern subjects.

Not only this but their real hindrances and challenges are coming when they want to participate in national level tests, they are not at in position to crack these tests due to lack of modern subjects such as the science, mathematics, and others. Inclusion of modern subjects, for instance Science, Mathematics, Humanities and Arts, and Basic Computer education will definitely produce the positive results. Religious subjects should be given the top priority to the education of the Holy Qur'an, Hadith, Islamic jurisprudence, and Arabic literature but teaching modern education cannot be ignored. They have to include some arts subjects like Science, Mathematics, Urdu, English, Political Science, Sociology, Economic, and basic computer knowledge. By doing this reform work, Madrasas will be to produce those talents which will be perfect in both Islamic education and modern education.

A major section of Muslims are economically backward and their children are enrolled in Madrasa and getting religious and modern education. So, only religious education is not going to sort out the problems of Muslims, but the combination of both is the real panacea of their problems. Positive change is always fruitful for any societies that want to remove their pathetic conditions and are ready to see their bright future. To be agnostic or atheist is not going to sort out our problems but a positive change is needed.

In Sambhal district, Many Madrasas are running and provides only Islamic education and few is both Islamic and Modern education but lacking of quality. As a result qualitative modern education with Islamic education is still a dream for marginalized muslim children in Sambhal district.

To fulfill this gap Horizon Gramudhyog Vikas Samiti has been running a registered residential Madrasa; **MADARSA GULSHANE NASEEM AREBIK ACADEMY** in Sambhal district of Uttar Pradesh since 2013. In which more than 700 children are getting qualitative Islamic and modern education. So far the functioning of the Madrasa is being managed by the organization through own funds and general public donations. However, of late it has become difficult to run the Madrasa in the absence of a corpus fund for the sustenance of the Madrasa.

Now as per need of the Madrasa, HGVS has decided to continue their support, for this purpose HGVS submitting a proposal in the prescribed format along with all the required documents for financial assistance for the support of Madrasa students through Setting of Library, Canteen, Hostel, Provision of Uniforms and Text Books in District Sambhal, Uttar Pradesh, India.

PROJECT PROPOSED

Taking into consideration the urgency of the situation and need of the area **HGVS** proposed a project for financial assistance **for the support of Madrasa students through Setting of Library, Canteen, Hostel, Provision of Uniforms and Text Books in District Sambhal, Uttar Pradesh, India.** The details of the proposed project and the other necessary documents are submitting for your kind perusal.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To make a model Madrasa for the rest of the community and produce those talents which will be perfect in both Islamic and modern education;
- To help the Muslim Students to receive valuable information that widens his/her interest, knowledge, abilities and better understanding of ARABIC, MATH, SCIENCE, ENGLISH and URDU for exciting career opportunities;

- To make the Muslim Students develop their values and skills so that they may become productive and effective citizens of the country;
- To provide quality religious and modern education to the Muslim children;
- To build an institutional framework for providing modern education to the deserving Muslim student.
- To ensure equality and fair opportunities to the school dropped Muslim children to pursue Arabic, Urdu and modern education.
- To keep the Muslim Students well informed and updated through religious and modern education.
- To help the Muslim Students rebuild and work towards achieving its goal, so that the hopes and aspiration of our generation is not buried by negative developments.
- To provide the Muslim Students good leadership for fruitful and worthy results in all aspects of life.
- To provide free of cost residential facilities along with meals to Madrasa students ;
- To promote sports education and library movement in Madrasa students;
- To provide free schooling, books, uniforms and stationeries to the poor needy students;
- To promote and foster community participation in running educational institutions through collective ownership and responsibility;
- To organize health checkup camp and provide free basic health facilities and quality medicines to poor.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT / METHODOLOGY

We like to implement the project for the development and the up liftment of the targeted community through quality based Islamic and Modern education in Sambhal District. In the first year the project team will start the selection of the students for the Madrasa. The main criterion behind the selection is that the economical background of the students and the availability of the nearby area. And those who are selected by the selection committee will be admitted in the Madrasa for the further studies. The project team will provide full support to the students including the hostel facilities. The hostel facilities will be provide to only those students those who come from very faraway places and the home atmosphere is not that well for their studies.

It is also proposed to set up the Madrasa and the official clearances required for starting and its functioning will be obtained by the society before it is made a full-fledged one.

Before implementing the project, Organization will do mobilise the community and distribute the IEC materials viz. pamphlets and hand outs. Organization will conduct the Madrasa teachers' training module and will provide the knowledge, tools and technique to volunteers about the Baseline Survey by master resource person.

This project would be completed with in a period of two years from the date of sanction. **HGVS** will implement the plan with the civil engineering and social care team. Project implementation, accounts, monitoring and reporting will be done as per the guidelines of the granting agency.

THE TIME FRAME OF THE PROJECT

Initially, the project has been planned basing on a two (2) year period for purposes of systematic costing.

MONITORING REPORTING AND EVALUATION

Monitoring:

The entire project will be monitored by the monitoring team and timely documentation and evaluation will be made on it. The monitoring team can be appointed by the funding agency or by the organization. The team will be monitoring the financial as well as the physical matters. however; **HGVS** team would monitor the quality, time, organizing manpower and progress. We like to make the monitoring team on the basis of community participation.

Reporting & Evaluation:

There will be a project manager to monitor the entire program and to document the activities. Progress report would be furnished on monthly basis and the same would be reported annually.

The project would be evaluated with the consultation and guidelines of the granting agency. Committee shall organize regular periodical review meeting to analyze whether the objectives of the project have been met and achieved it will be the self evaluation routine process of the institution.

Community Participation and post Project Sustainability:

After completion of the project for the two year in educational Program it will be sustained with the involvement and participation of community people. Program will be run with the joint efforts of organization and community itself. Following points can be described as an important part of post project sustainability.

1. **Financial Aspects:** After Completion of the project, financial management will be the priority work to sustain the program. Contribution can be arranged from different sources. First of all free education center will be converted in to low cost centers. Student will be charged a nominal amount as tuition fee.
2. **Community Participation:** Community leader will be involved in post Project activities. They can help for sensitizing people, door to door campaign and communication the beneficiaries' parents. Community leader will be expected to help financially also. They can play important role in collecting funds from the community. Parents can help by giving copies, pencils and other study materials to their children.
3. **Organizational Supports:** Organization will manage the whole process of sustainability after completion of the project as for as finance is concerned. Organization will arrange it by the donation, community contribution and through other mode(s). Help can be taken from different government and non government agencies too.

THE PROFILE OF THE ORGANIZATION

Horizon Gramudhyog Vikas Samiti is a non-profitable and non-governmental voluntary organization registered under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 (**Regd. No.- 823/2009-2010, Dated on 28th July 2009**).

Horizon Gramudhyog Vikas Samiti (**HGVS**) is a overall integrated Development Organization which committed to work for the development and upliftment of the vulnerable groups to eradicate poverty and also dedicated to improve the environmental hazards. We as an NGO is working to promote and provide qualitative education to neglected children and down trodden communities which are socially and economically deprived. Further more we emphasize these children's latest talents and explore, so that they not only acquire academic learning, but also vocational proficiency, personal character and societal values. We work for their retention until they become self reliant and responsible citizens.

HGVS emphasis on the formal education for drop-out and non enroll children. As per statistical data there are large numbers of drop out and hardly 50% boys and 30% girls qualify 10+2 standard though the facilities are available in every village of India. We had surveyed in the several villages where we came to know the facts and factual reasons of drop outs and our study says the following drastic reasons.

HGVS leads the community towards good health through its health program. We organize health awareness camps in which Doctor diagnose the disease and refer the patients in Government Hospitals where confessional rates are charged. We also organize Eye screening camps in the villages where cataract patients are benefited by referring the patients for IOL operation on very minimum charges. The patient who has weak eye sight is given spectacles on confessional rates.

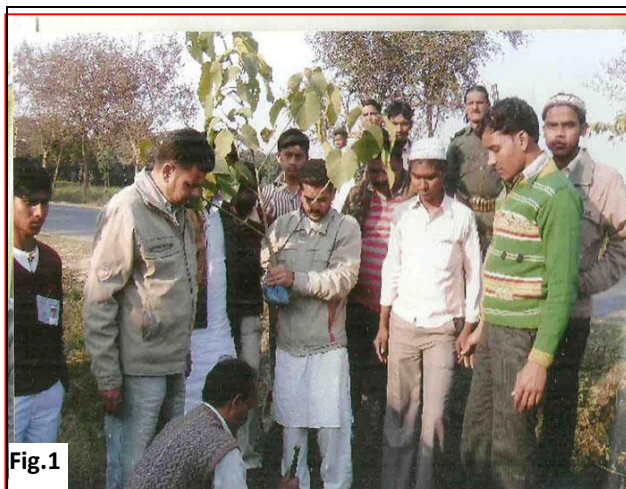

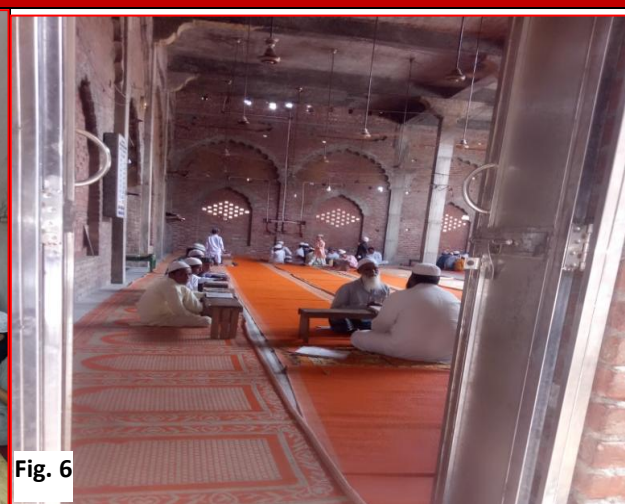

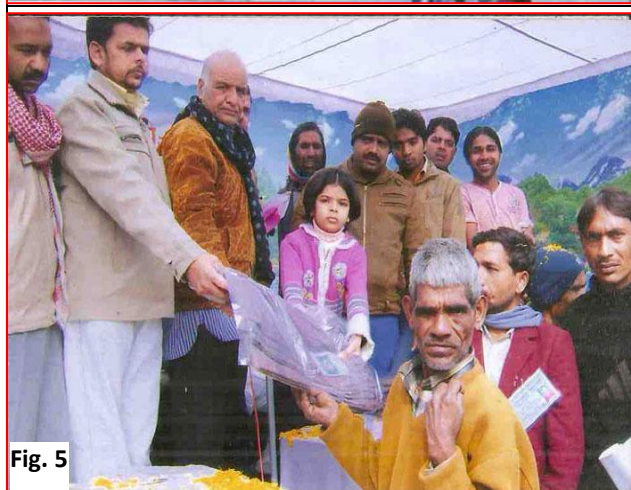

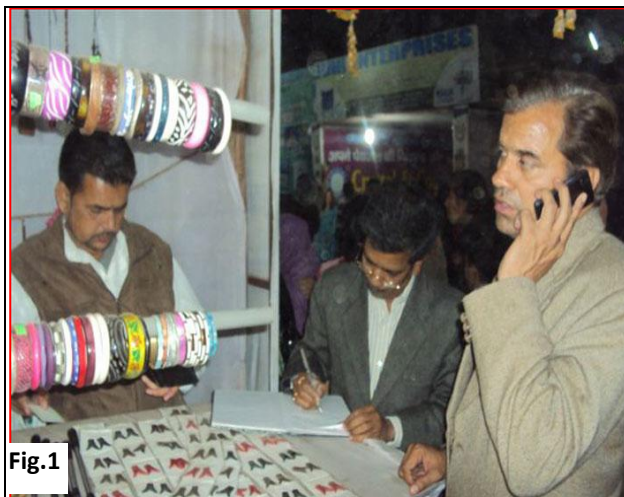

PROFILE OF PROJECT AREA – SAMBHAL DISTRICT, UTTAR PRADESH

Sambhal is a Muslim majority city in India with approximately 77.67% of city population following Islam as their religion. Hinduism is second most popular religion in city of Sambhal with approximately 22.00% following it. The total population of Sambhal over 21 lacs has become one of the most crowded cities in Uttar Pradesh.

Today, the city of Sambhal is famous for manufacturing of its unique kinds of horn and bone crafts items which are being exported. There is an exponential increase in environmental pollution and occupational health hazards due to rapid industrialization. The food stuffs are largely adulterated, drinking water supply becoming scare and unsafe for consumption and lastly industries and automobiles have increased the atmospheric air pollution to an alarmingly unsafe levels. This has led to a steep fall in health standards of the people.

1. Sambhal Population 2011

As per provisional reports of Census India, population of Sambhal in 2011 is 221,334; of which male and female are 116,008 and 105,326 respectively. Although Sambhal city has population of 221,334; its urban / metropolitan population is 0 of which 0 are males and 0 are females.

2. Sambhal Literacy Rate 2011

In education section, total literates in Sambhal city are 92,608 of which 51,382 are males while 41,226 are females. Average literacy rate of Sambhal city is 49.51 percent of which male and female literacy was 52.27 and 46.45 percent.

3. **Sambhal Sex Ratio 2011**

The sex ratio of Sambhal city is 908 per 1000 males. Child sex ratio of girls is 936 per 1000 boys.

4. **Sambhal Child Population 2011**

Total children (0-6) in Sambhal city are 34,279 as per figure from Census India report on 2011. There were 17,702 boys while 16,577 are girls. The child forms 15.49 % of total population of Sambhal City.
